What is the Christmas message **in a single** statement?

The Christmas message **is a story**

.....

- Though it was foretold centuries before...
- It was lived out **real time**, with **real people**
- What was the message **to those people**?

Act 1, **scene 1** begins with Zacharias... (Luke 1:5-35)

- He unexpectedly encountered an angel (Who expects an angel?)
- Not just any angel Gabriel! The Herald of The Lord...
- Who STANDS in the very presence of God!
- And his life became unusual unprecedented, even

......

 Whatever he had expected was taken from him

Act 2, scene 1 brings Mary on stage... (Luke 1:26-38)

- She also unexpectedly encounters **an angel**
- Once again Gabriel! (This guy doesn't do light work)
- She is not a priest alone in The Holy of Holies!
- She is a unmarried, engaged, devout, pure young woman
- She is told she'll become a pregnant, still unmarried virgin...
- Pregnant with The Incarnation of GOD!
- No doubt, NOT what she anticipated

- His role doesn't begin with an unexpected angel
- His part begins with an incomprehensible shock!
- But he is a kind, merciful man who hopes to deal with it quietly
- **THEN** the angel (No I.D.) shows up and enlightens him

Fast forward to Act 4, scene 2... (Luke 2:8-14)

......

- A group of lowly shepherds are out in the sticks at night
- **SUDDENLY** an angel shows up in front of them, and...
- THE GLORY OF THE LORD flips the house & stage lights on BRIGHT!
- He tells them THE Good News!!
- **MESSIAH** has just been born in the little town near by...
- In a feeding trough, in a barn. (What else would you expect?)

So – What's the Christmas message?

Because the angel said **the exact same thing** to **ALL** of them

Do Not Be Afraid!

- What would Zacharias have to fear?
- What would Mary have to fear?
- What would Joseph have to fear?
- What would the shepherds have to fear?

Act 3, **scene 1** introduces her fiancé, Joseph

It's not what prompts fear that should concern us Fear would be a very natural, understandable response - don't you think? We all face it Maybe the Supernatural deserves more It's fear itself than a natural response... - Especially if it's obviously **from God**. He's Fear, when hosted - separates us from God! not out to get us. God IS safety & security!! What do people rightly have to fear? Why was God angry with His people in **Hebrews Death & the Judgement of God!! 3:6-4:16?** - **They chose fear** over faith & trust in God Jesus came to **DESTROY** death, and... Was it threatening & dangerous? Make God's judgement the best thing we ever get! Absolutely!! Why is God adamant that we **Do NOT** fear?

- Fear **disables** faith
- Fear **displaces** faith
- Fear **negates** faith
- Fear is **of the flesh**, not God **He has none** to give
- Fear **removes** God from **FIRST place** in our lives
- Fear **disempowers** us
- Fear & Faith **Do NOT** cohabitate!
